September Theme: Responsibility and Integrity

Guidance Tip of the Month: Some of the greatest tools in our lives are commitment and our word. Integrity is based on standing by our commitments and keeping our word while pledging to be honest and responsible in all that we do. Personal responsibility is taking accountability for our own actions.

Responsibility is defined as the state or fact of being answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management.

Integrity is defined as the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness. **Moral** is defined as concerned with the principles of right and wrong behavior and the goodness or badness of human character.

*Things I am responsible for include: Obeying my parents, doing my chores, cleaning my room, treating others kindly, I represent my family when I am in public, obeying school staff, completing homework/classwork, preparing and studying for quizzes and tests, etc.

**I do all the above things even if no one is watching: this is integrity.
