Placement of Pronouns

(Reflexive / Indirect and Direct Object Pronouns)

Pronombre del complemento directo. (Direct object pronouns)

* Before conjugated verbs: (No) Lo estoy leyendo. (present progressive) I'm (not)reading it.

> I (don't)read it, I'm (not)reading it. (No)Lo leo. (present)

(No)Lo leí. (preterite) I (didn't) read it. ¡No lo comas! (negative command) Don't eat it!

Lo habríamos visto (conditional) We would have seen him/it.

*Attached to conjugated verbs: ¡Lée<mark>lo</mark>! (affirmative command) Read it!

*Attached to participles: Estoy leyéndo<mark>lo</mark> (present progressive) I'm reading it.

*Attached to infinitives: Quiero leer<mark>lo</mark> (present) I want to read it.

Pronombre del complemento indirecto. (Indirect object pronoun)

* Before conjugated verbs: Le gusta el libro (present) He/she likes the book.

Le estoy leyendo I'm reading to him/her. (present progressive) No <mark>le</mark> hables a èl (negative command) Don't talk to him.

Te habríamos visto (conditional perfect) We would have seen him/it. (conditional) I would tell you my address. Te diría mi dirección

(presnt perfect) We have seen him/it. Te hemos visto

Lée<mark>le</mark> el libro. *Attached to conjugated verbs: (affirmative command) Read the book to him/her

*Attached to infinitives: Quiero hablar<mark>le</mark> (present) I want to speak to him/her.

*Attached to participles: Estoy leyéndo<mark>le</mark> (present progressive) I'm reading to him/her.

Pronombres reflexivos (reflexive pronouns)

* Before conjugated verbs: Te bañas (present) You bathe (You're bathing.)

Te voy a bañar (present) You're going to bathe.

Te tienes que bañar. You have to bathe (wash-up). (present)

Te estás bañando (present progressive) You're bathing. No te bañes (negative command) Don't bathe. (conditional) Me despertaría I would wake up.

(conditional perfect) Me habría despertado I would have woken up.

*Attached to conjugated verbs: Báña<mark>te</mark> ahora. (affirmative command) Bathe (wash-up) now.

Vas a bañar<mark>te</mark> (present) You're going to bathe.

You have to bathe (wash-up). Tienes que bañar<mark>te</mark> (present)

*Attached to infinitives: Vas a bañar<mark>te</mark> (presente) You're going to bathe. You have to bathe Tienes que bañar<mark>te</mark> (presente)

*Attached to participles: Estás bañándote (present progressive) You're bathing (washing-up)
