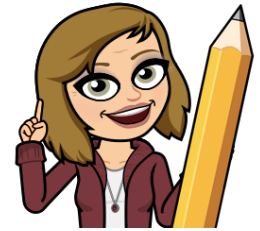

**Test begins promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will be over around 12:30 p.m.*

Test Format: The PSAT/NMSQT has four 25 minute sections (two critical reading & two math) & one 30 minute section (writing skills). We have allocated 3 hours total to accommodate related activities

Some practical Advice:

- ✓ *Take the complete practice test contained in the PSAT student bulletin you received when you registered.*
- ✓ *Learn the format and timing of the test*
- ✓ *Become familiar with kinds of questions asked*
- ✓ *Know the directions for each kind of question*
- ✓ *Learn the difference between random and educated guessing- there is a penalty for incorrect answers.*

Test Results: *Students should receive scores in December. Scores range from 20-80 (equitable to SAT 200-800) for each section of verbal and math. If you score high as a Sophomore, you may want to take the PSAT again as a junior to try to obtain the National Merit Scholarship.*
