If a student chooses to take a class off campus, the off-campus placeholder must be at the <u>beginning or the end of the</u> <u>day</u> AND the student must have <u>daily transportation to/from campus</u>. Note: Students <u>CANNOT</u> stay on campus during an off-campus placeholder.
- Students who choose to take Dual Enrollment must meet the requirements listed below and have daily transportation if taking the class online or off-campus. Students must leave campus. Students cannot stay on campus during an off-campus PHSC placeholder. Off-campus PHSC placeholders must be at the beginning or the end of the day. All DE students must fill out an online Dynamic Form requesting classes at JWMHS as well as those online/at PHSC. Students taking off campus PHSC classes must register for their classes through the PHSC website. Students taking DE classes online or off-campus, must pick up books as outlined on the district Dual Enrollment page.
