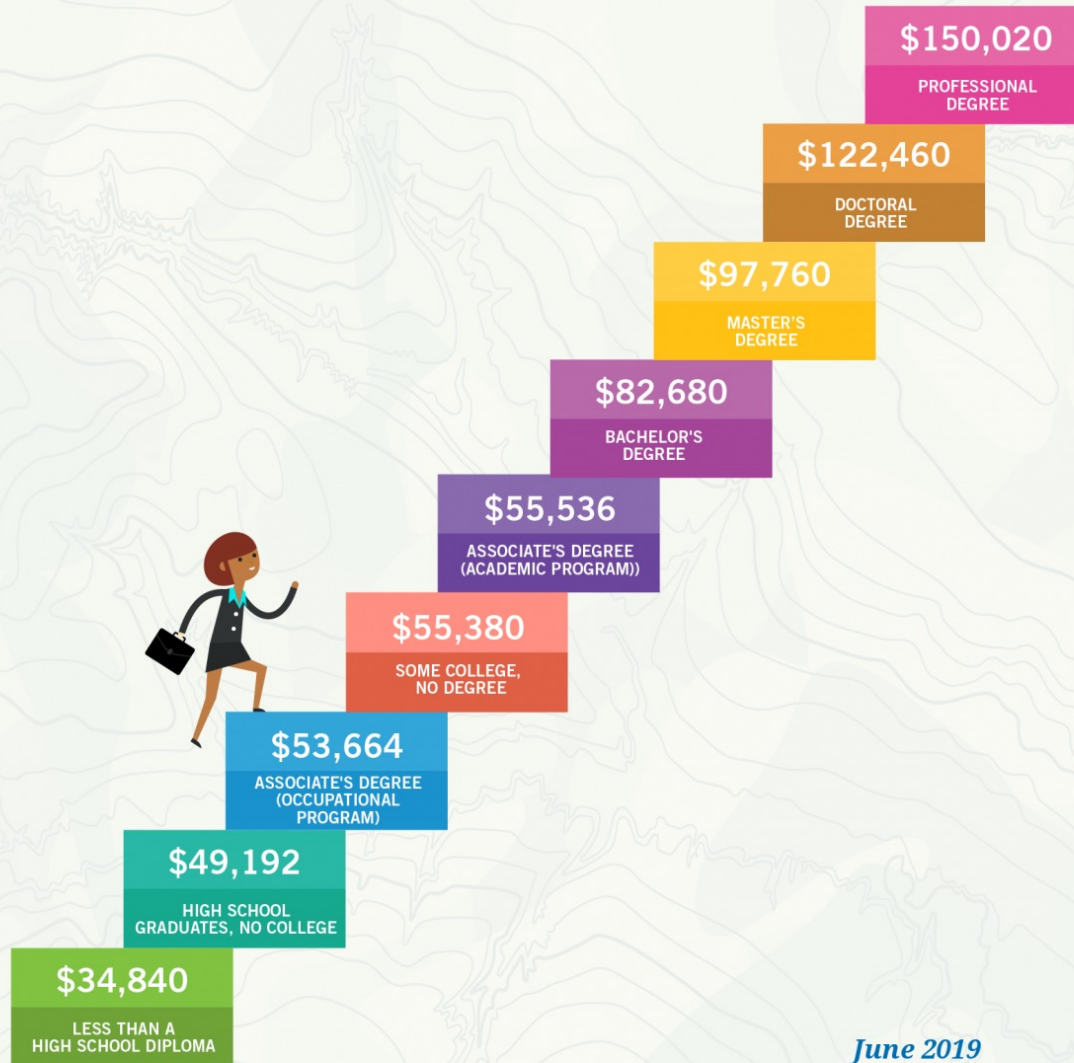

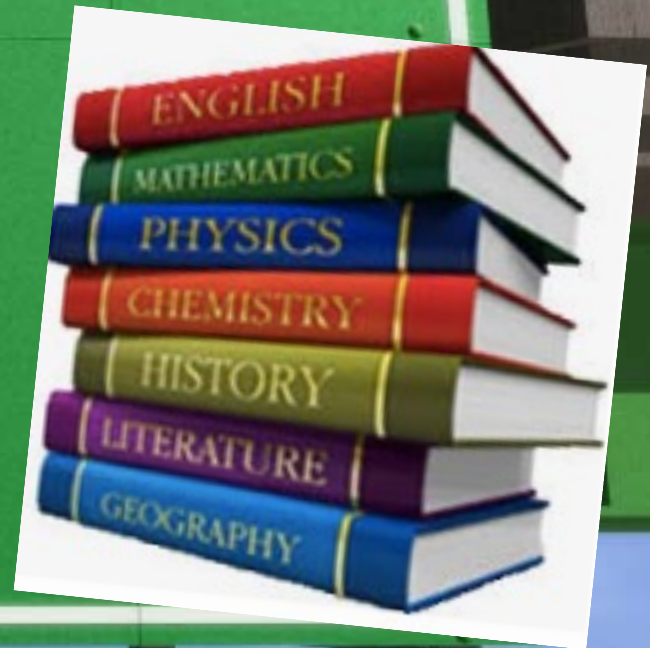

Whatever your major, you need to know how to find & analyze information and evaluate the sources. *Taking challenging courses in different subject areas can help students*

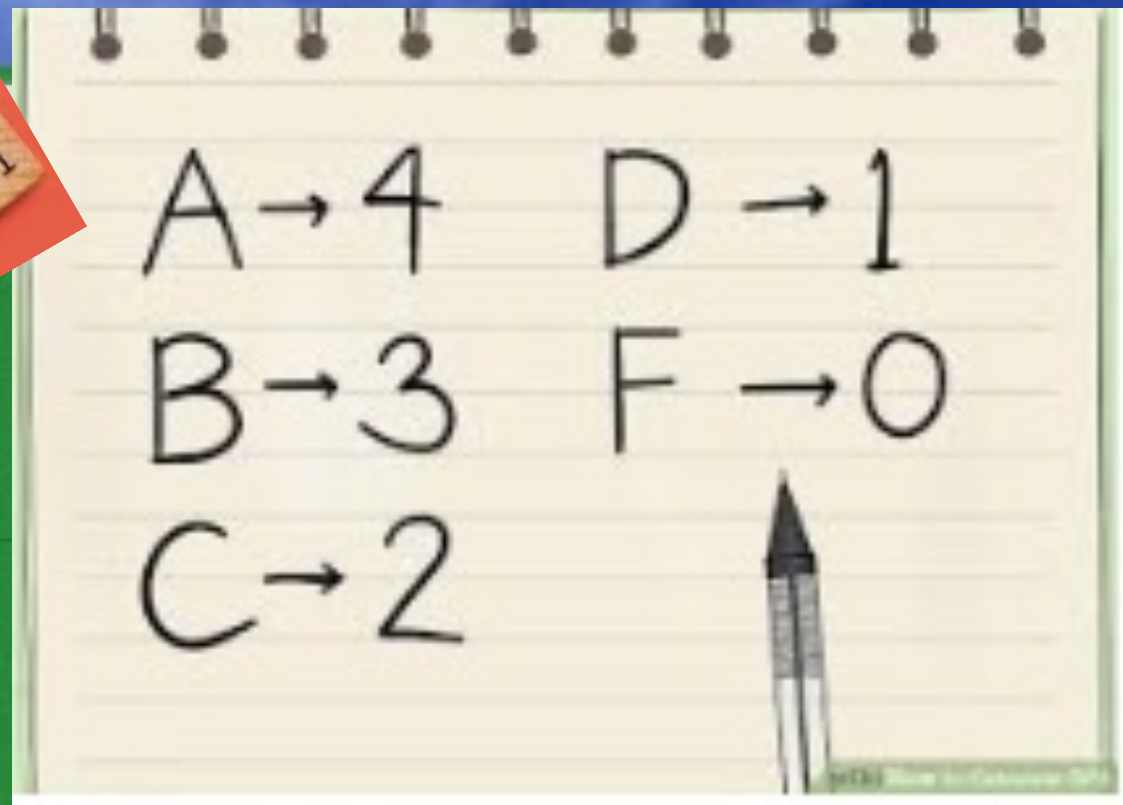
