



To access an award through the Bright Futures Program, a student must complete a program of community service work OR 100 hours of paid work, as approved by the school.

What is paid work experience?

- Employment completed through a business with an established Federal ID Number.
- Work hours completed after July 1, 2022, that are properly documented via pay stubs or a generated report or letter from employer verifying hours worked.
- New in 2023: Community Service and Work Hours may be combined for the purposes of meeting the Bright Futures requirements. Students must earn either the required volunteer service, paid work hours, or the combination of 100 total hours for eligibility.


