The following document represents an agreement between you, a JWMHS student, and J.W. Mitchell High School. It is your responsibility to resolve any and all questions concerning any of the terms and conditions listed in this agreement prior to the date of the Dance. If you and/or your guest fail to meet any of the terms or conditions listed in this agreement you understand that you and/or your guest will be required to leave the event and that no refund of the ticket price will be issued. In consideration of being sold a ticket and being granted admission to J.W. Mitchell High School's Dance you agree to the following terms and conditions:

NO RE-ENTRY and STUDENT BEHAVIOR

There will be no re-entry to the Dance at JWMHS. Once you and/or your guest enter the facility at JWMHS and relinquish your wristband(s)/ticket(s) to the event, you and/or your guest are prohibited from leaving and re-entering the facility. JWMHS reserves the right per the Student Code of Conduct and statute, upon reasonable suspicion to search all cars, party busses, and limos, as well as purses and other belongings. This dance is a vape free, tobacco free, drug free, and alcohol-free activity. The use of tobacco products, drugs, and alcohol is NOT permitted. We STRONGLY RECOMMEND NOT employing limousines or party buses.

IDENTIFICATION

You must provide one of the following in order to gain admittance to the Dance: a school ID, a government issued ID, a passport, or a driver license. We recommend that you either take a picture of your ID and have it on your phone or that you bring a paper copy of your ID. There will be no exceptions whatsoever, even if school personnel at the event recognize you and/or your guest.

DRESS CODE

The following dress code is applicable to all students and guests who wish to enter the Dance. *All guests must comply with all school and Code of Conduct requirements.* Any student or guest that fails to meet any of the following conditions will be denied entry to the event. The principal's/designee's decision is **FINAL**.

Permitted Clothing:

- If wearing pants, dress pants, dress shirt and dress shoes are appropriate. A tie and jacket is strongly recommended. All pants must be securely worn around the waist. No "polo" style shirts will be allowed.
- If not wearing pants, dresses, skirts, or a gown that is in good taste are appropriate. Strapless dresses are allowed. Two-piece dresses will be allowed; however, please make sure that the front necklines shall not be lower than a line formed between the right and left armpit as cleavage needs to be in good taste.
- If you are unsure of whether or not your outfit will meet dress code expectations for this event, please email any administrator for clarification. It is your responsibility to seek prior approval for administration. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before that evening. The principal's/designee's decision is **FINAL**.

Clothing that Violates the Dress Code:

- Students dressed inappropriately will be turned away at the door. Adjustments made at the door or during the dance (including pinning, the addition of a jacket, the addition of a body suit, etc.) will not be accepted as solutions for violations of the dress code.
- Clothing that is see-through will not be permitted. All undergarments and genitalia must remain covered throughout the dance.
- Students will not be admitted wearing cargo pants, sneakers, jeans/denim, khakis, Dickies (or other casual pants), t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products.
- Athletics shoes/sneakers (i.e. Nikes, Adidas, etc.) or work boots will not be permitted. The principal's/designee's decision is **FINAL**.

DANCE FLOOR BEHAVIOR

Sexually suggestive dancing is not appropriate and will not be tolerated. This includes grinding, grind trains, bending over, straddling legs, lap dancing, etc. Inappropriate touching is also prohibited. If these expectations are not followed, the lights will be turned on in the gymnasium. If students continue to not follow expectations, they will be asked to leave without refund. Verbal warnings will be given via the DJ and the music changed as a collective warning for everyone. Appropriate dancing includes, hands on the waist or shoulders only, both feet on the floor, and respectful public displays of affection.

END OF DANCE PROCEDURES

Students are not allowed to re-enter the dance upon leaving. Once you have left the dance, you CANNOT, under any circumstances re-enter. Students must vacate the premises within 30 minutes of the dance ending.
