What is the ASVAB?

- The ASVAB stands for the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery Test
- A standardized test used to rate an individual's aptitude for service in the United States Armed Forces.
- It helps recruitment officers determine an individual's suitability for particular branches of service or for specific military jobs. It is used by the Air Force, Army, Marine Corps, Navy, and Coast Guard.
- It is NOT an intelligence test, but rather a test of one's individual strengths and weaknesses in areas such as math, science, and reading, as well as one's current knowledge of specific mechanical, electronic, automotive, and shop concepts.
- You are under NO obligation to enlist in the military to take the ASVAB, if you'd like to get an idea of possible careers or college majors Take the ASVAB
