J.W. MITCHELL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT AGREEMENT

ONLY DONE IF STUDENT/GUEST IS CURRENT STUDENT AT JWMHS

The following document represents an agreement between you, a JWMHS student, and J.W. Mitchell High School. It is your responsibility to resolve any and all questions concerning any of the terms and conditions listed in this agreement prior to the date of the Homecoming. If you and/or your guest fail to meet any of the terms or conditions listed in this agreement you understand that you and/or your guest will be required to leave the event and that no refund of the ticket price will be issued. In consideration of being sold a ticket and being granted admission to J.W. Mitchell High School's Homecoming you agree to the following expectations, terms, and conditions:

NO RE-ENTRY and STUDENT BEHAVIOR

There is an expectation that students will behave in accordance with the Pasco County School District Student Code of Conduct. There will be no re-entry to Homecoming at JWMHS. Once you and/or your guest enter the facility at JWMHS and relinquish your ticket(s) to the event, you and/or your guest are prohibited from leaving and re-entering the facility. JWMHS reserves the right per the Student Code of Conduct and statute, upon reasonable suspicion to search all cars, party busses, and limos, as well as purses and other belongings. This dance is a vape free, tobacco free, drug free, and alcohol free activity. The use of vapes, tobacco products, drugs, and alcohol is NOT permitted. We STRONGLY RECOMMEND NOT employing limousines or party buses.

IDENTIFICATION

You must provide one of the following in order to gain admittance to the Homecoming: a school ID, a government issued ID, a passport, or a driver license. We recommend that you either take a picture of your ID and have it on your phone or that you bring a paper copy of your ID. There will be no exceptions whatsoever, even if school personnel at the event recognize you and/or your guest.

DRESS CODE

The following dress code is applicable to all students and guests who wish to enter the Homecoming. All guests must comply with all school and Code of Conduct requirements. If you have questions concerning your dress, it is your responsibility to seek prior approval for administration. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before that evening. Any student or guest that fails to meet any of the following conditions will be denied entry to the event:

All students must wear formal or semi-formal attire appropriate for a school-sponsored event. Acceptable attire includes: a dress, gown, pantsuit, formal jumpsuit, or coordinated two-piece formal outfit, dress pants with a dress shirt, formal footwear, such as dress shoes, heels, dress sandals, or flats, a tie and jacket are strongly recommended when wearing dress pants and a dress shirt.

All clothing must fit securely and provide appropriate coverage throughout the dance. Pants must be worn securely at the waist. Clothing may not be see-through or expose intimate areas. Strapless and two-piece formal outfits are permitted; however, necklines must provide appropriate coverage, and all parts of the outfit must remain securely in place. Students wearing shorter dresses or skirts are strongly encouraged to wear fitted shorts underneath.

The following items are not permitted: Polo-style shirts, T-shirts, or other casual shirts, jeans, denim, khakis, cargo pants, Dickies, shorts, or other casual pants, Work boots, torn clothing, chains, spikes, or similar accessories, clothing containing sexually suggestive or explicit content, clothing or accessories referencing tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or other prohibited products, and hats, bandanas, or nonreligious head coverings.

Students whose attire does not meet these expectations will not be admitted. Adjustments made at the door or during the dance—including pinning clothing or adding a jacket, bodysuit, or other garment—will not be accepted as a solution to a dress-code violation.

The principal or designee will make the final determination regarding whether attire complies with the dress code. That decision is FINAL.

DANCE FLOOR BEHAVIOR

Sexually suggestive dancing is not appropriate and will not be tolerated. This includes grinding, grind trains, bending over, straddling legs, lap dancing, etc. Inappropriate touching is also prohibited. If these expectations are not followed, the lights will be turned on in the gymnasium. If students continue to not follow expectations, they will be asked to leave without refund. Verbal warnings will be given via the DJ and the music changed as a collective warning for everyone. Appropriate dancing includes, hands on the waist or shoulders only, both feet on the floor, and respectful public displays of affection.

END OF DANCE PROCEDURES

Students are not allowed to re-enter the dance upon leaving. Once you have left the dance, you CANNOT, under any circumstances re-enter. Students must vacate the premises within 30 minutes of the dance ending.
